

# ADVANCED RIFLE TRAINING CLASS

**Purpose:** To teach advanced rifle handling and shooting techniques to those who already have basic knowledge in shooting. ## Daily Class Curriculum

### Day 1

- Understanding your weapon
- How to use different shooting positions; supported and unsupported
- Types of breathing techniques and how to use them
- Weapons optics; understanding how to use them
- Weapons positioning; how to hold your rifle, proper trigger control
- Weather conditions and how it will affect your bullet

### Day 2

- Practical application to all topics discussed prior
- Range time

## Items needed for class

- Pad of paper and pen for note taking
- Spotting scope (optional)
- Weapon with optics: can be any centerfire caliber and style of weapon with an adjustable scope.
- 100 rounds of ammo
- Cleaning kit
- Ear and Eye protection

**Prerequisites:** *Knowledge and understanding of firearm safety.* A basic understanding of your weapon, shooting, and marksmanship techniques. Physically able to get into and out of standard shooting positions (standing, sitting, prone, and kneeling).
