**Fantastic Changes both Inside and Out!!**

The last year has brought many improvements to the Cadillac Sportsman's Club both inside the clubhouse and on the grounds. In the spring after the indoor programs ended, Dennis Meekhof took on the often discussed and yet to be started, indoor renovation project. He spent many hours ripping down paneling, insulating, furring out walls, drywalling, painting & cleaning up. When scouting with his sons changed his life schedule, he handed the project over to other capable hands for further progress. Finally the project is 99 % complete. The entire interior of the clubhouse has been insulated, re-wired, drywalled, & painted. All new double paned ins<sup>[a]</sup>ulated vinyl windows have been installed. All these improvements have undoubtedly caused our propane supplier some distress, but we should see the investment in dollars and sweat equity come back in a short time with lower energy bills! The indoor shooting programs will be much more comfortable and the clubhouse looks cleaner and larger with smooth walls and new windows.

Then in late Oct. we had Dunbar Excavating come in and "give" us about 4000 yrds. of fill that they needed to relocate from a project down the road. We have to pay for some dozer work & fuel charges to spread the dirt, but the 600 yrd. range can be mowed completely and easily now. They also brought in gravel for the roads to the practice rifle and pistol ranges, dug out that pesky stump in the middle of the front yard along with a couple other trees, and spread gravel and compacted the parking area and entrance. In the spring we have a commitment from a friend of conservation to seed that new dirt on the range with wildlife mix to make us a haven for the critters.

Next years projects will focus on the Practice Rifle Range to extend and enclose the roof over area and to replace the target frames. So if you missed out on all the fun of volunteering for these projects make sure to let us know you are interested in helping on next years. We always have projects that need someone to volunteer a few hours to get done.
